Medicine and Surgery





Medicine/Surgery:

At Soteria: We do **NOT** teach against doctors or medicine.

- We have NOR will EVER say throw away your medicine and rely on confessions alone.
- Don't do this UNLESS God tells you to do this.

It takes time to renew your mind and develop faith in your words as well as God's Word.



Walking in Truth Concerning Healing Medicine/Surgery:

If you need a doctor, see a doctor.

There are medicines today that are beneficial in aiding the body's healing process. They simply help the symptoms until your faith kicks in.

Medicine/Surgery:

AND in a life or death situation where the doctors say you need an operation immediately or you will die - in other words- the disease has a head start on your faith—then our advice would be to have the operation and believe God for a speedy recovery.

Walking in Truth Concerning Healing Medicine/Surgery:

 But don't depend on doctors or medicine <u>alone</u> to keep you healthy.

 There are more diseases that medical science cannot cure.

• BUT JESUS HEALED THEM ALL!!!

Side Effects***:

If you are taking medicine, mix faith with it by saying, "I believe I receive my healing in Jesus' Name."

Medicine/Surgery:

Prayer:

"I declare that the medications and treatments will do what they are intended to do and be a benefit to my body. These medications and medical interventions will not harm my body or cause an adverse reaction in my body. My God has delivered me from any destructions [Psalms 103:41?"



There is no <u>set</u> way by which people may receive healing. But, there are various <u>methods</u> for receiving healing as recorded in the Word of God.





Why?

Because God loves us so much, He wants to meet us where we are because of that love.





 He wants to touch your life no matter where you are in the kingdom.

 And we are <u>all</u> in <u>different</u> places and stages in our walk of faith.





Example: Salvation

 Most have changed since you first started walking with with God.

 You understand differently than you did when you first got saved.





Salvation:

• Even if you have been saved a short time, or have been worshipping at Soteria a short or long time, you have learned some things about God and you are growing in your understanding and knowledge about God.

But still, many of us are at different stages in our walk with God—and this "Walk of Faith."





1. Some things are easier to understand than others

Some things you grasp quickly and it makes sense and other things you have to meditate on it because it goes against previous teachings—hard to embrace.





Examples:

- Raising or Lifting Hands
- Dancing
- Sweeping
- Tongues





2. Some methods of receiving are more comfortable for people than others.

• What happens when you meet someone new?

You're more reserved when you meet someone you don't know. But as you get to know them you open up more and more.



• It's the same thing when you first hear and begin to walk this walk of faith with God.

 When you meet God, you don't really know Him.

• Trust????





- You can't trust someone—even God—when you really don't know Him—and we're not talking about what you heard about Him through someone else.
- Many have a religious relationship with "the man upstairs," but know nothing about Him and when we say just believe—the man cried out help my unbelief.

- The more you walk with Him, you get more comfortable with Him and His Promises.
- Etchings in your helmet [Won't He do It?]





3. All methods testify of God's will to heal.

4. All methods are an EXTENSION of God's love and compassion for people.





Ways you can receive your healing





Remember you are healed already: these are simply methods to receive what you already have been given!

God has provided <u>several</u> methods <u>to</u> increase our faith as we seek to receive divine healing!





- 1. Laying on of hands.
- 2. Anointing with oil.
- 3. Prayer of Agreement [SCCI & KCM CONFERENCE ATTENDEES].
- 4. Gifts of Holy Spirit****: Manifestations of Holy Spirit—

5. Faith in God's Word (The Name of Jesus) Learning how to believe God's Word; stand on His word and put faith in the Name of Jesus.

6. Signs and Wonders [Unexplainable mysteries of God]—we don't know how it happened but it was miraculous—we are in those days now: God invading our world with unexplainable proofs.



Bottom Line:

The loving compassionate nature of God:

GOD'S WILL IS TO HEAL—IT IS WHO HE IS—JEHOVAH RAPHA; HE CAN'T HELP IT.

WHEN HE SHOWS UP DEMONS
FLEE—HEALING COMES—IT'S JUST
